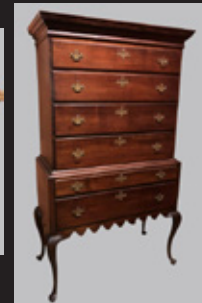

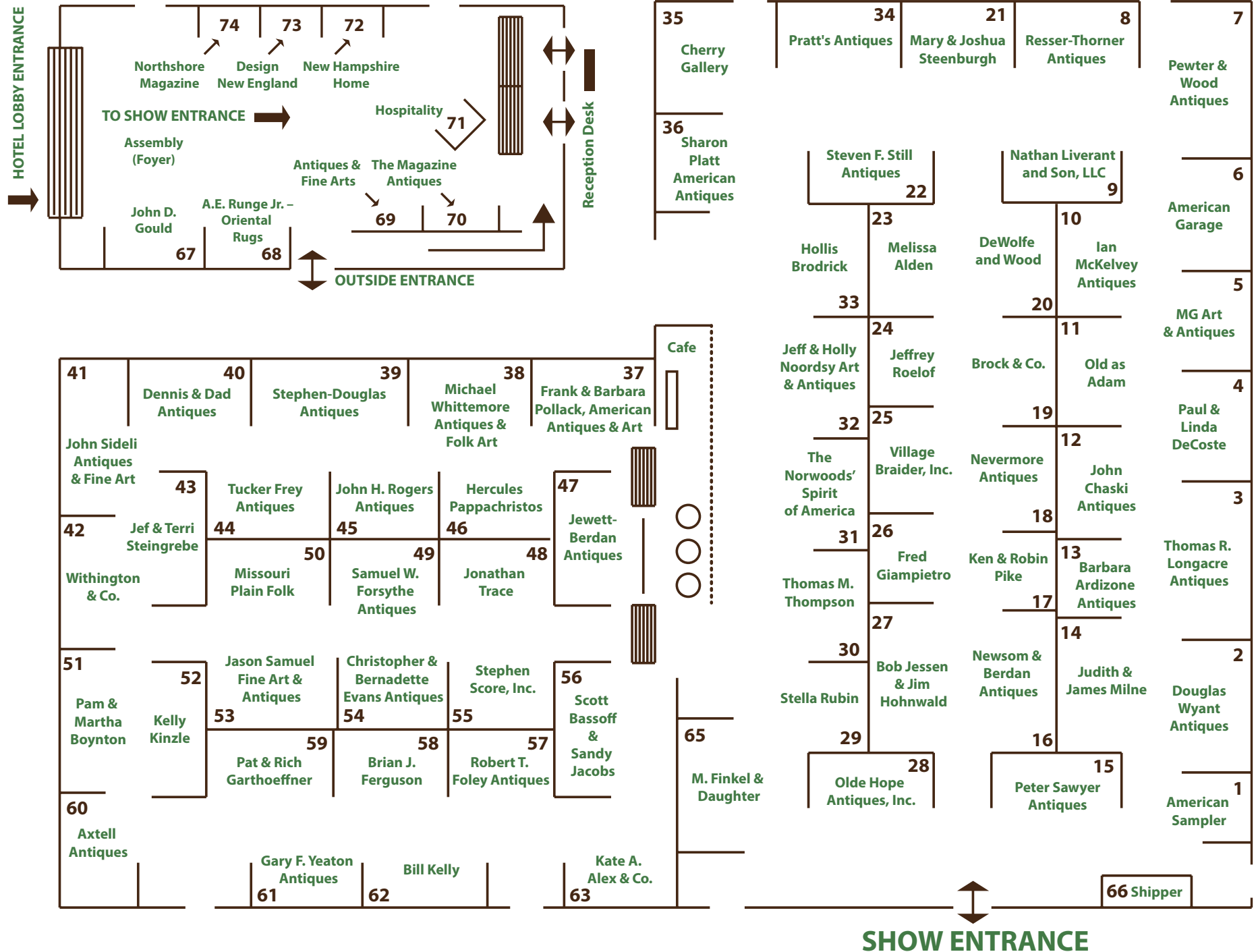

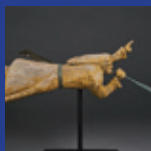


Pilot House Eagle

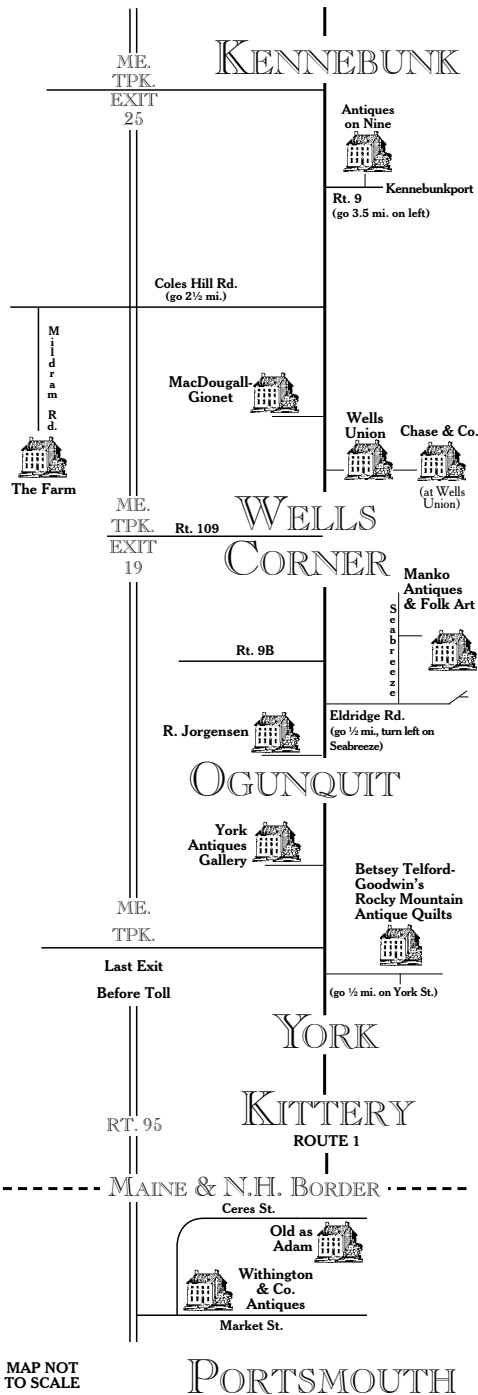

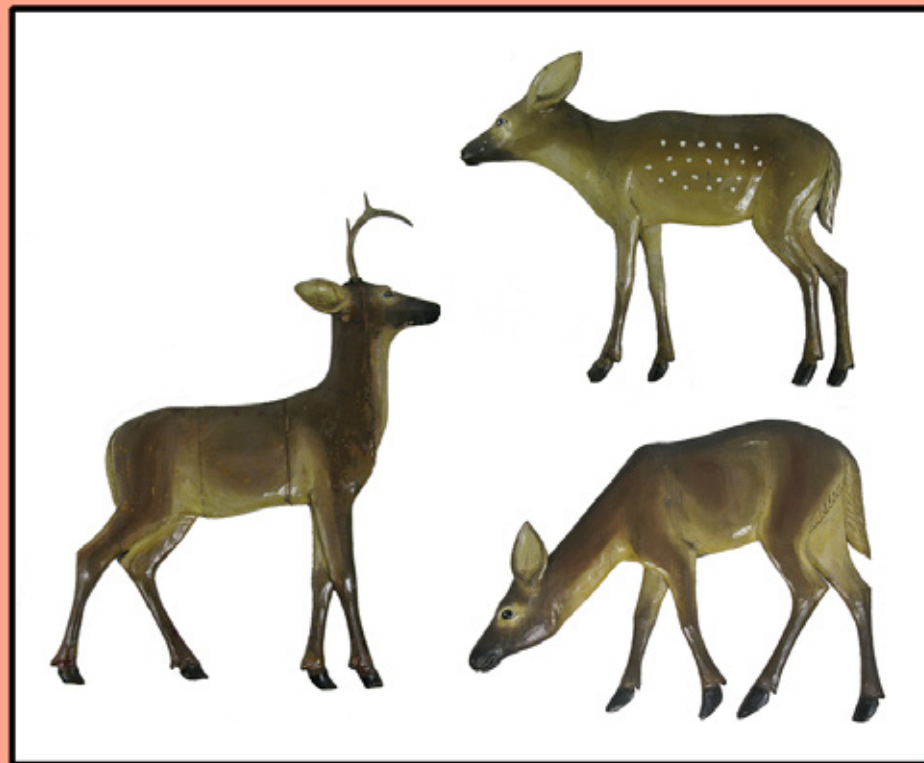
