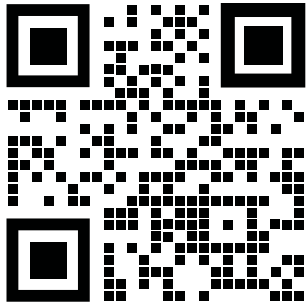

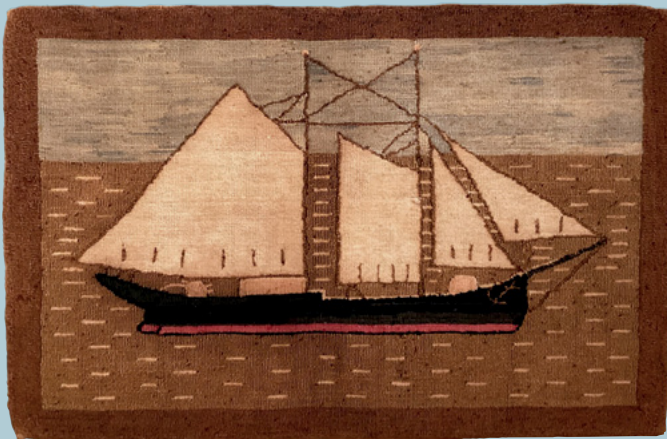

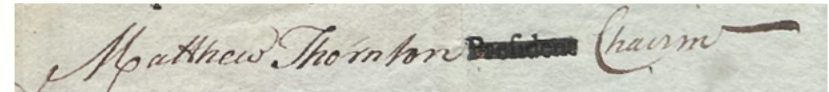

**Declaration of Independence Signer  
 Matthew Thornton Issues a Commission**

In 1775, Thornton (1714-1803) served as President of the New Hampshire Provincial Congress and then as Chairman of The Committee of Safety. He is considered one of the Founding Fathers. The document (12" x 6.5", sight) has transitional elements with the updating of Thornton's new title.

This commission is accomplished entirely in the hand of Thornton. In it, Porter Kimball of Brentwood is being appointed First Lieutenant in Captain Benjamin Boardman's (Twenty-Second) Company. He served at Winter Hill and Saratoga. Interestingly, Kimball was a slaveholder, and as a result of making a promise to his former slave, Scipio Duce, the latter successfully prosecuted a claim against the Porter Estate in 1794 and was awarded damages in the amount of \$240.
